Dear Councillor Lea

I refer to your enquiries on behalf of residents, regarding the road condition at Lismore Street, Abermain.

*I've been contacted by a number of residents regarding the state of Lismore Street, Abermain with the road surface currently poor at best.*

*Many feel the deterioration of this asset was accelerated by the road being used as a detour during the Orange Street roadworks undertaken in 2024.*

*Are there any currently plans for rectification?*

Additional email:

*A number of residents have reached out to me regarding the state of Lismore St, Abermain with many noting the deterioration of the asset was exacerbated by additional traffic volume during the 2024 Orange St roadworks.*

*Can we confirm if/when remediation of Lismore St is planned.*

Council officers have investigated the subject matter and advise as follows:

Lismore Street, Abermain has been identified for stabilisation works and potential road widening under the draft SRV scenario. Council acknowledges that the road wearing surface has progressively deteriorated over time and has been identified for rehabilitation to improve safety and durability.

The timing of these works is yet to be confirmed, Council Officer's will focus on road rehabilitations in accordance with the matrix included in the Asset Management Plan.
