

Wollombi Road Upgrade: Community Notice

31 July 2025

UPDATE: Zone 3 Traffic changes to commence Monday 4 August

What you need to know:

- Previously notified night works for Thursday 31 July, now moved to Monday 4
 August due to wet weather
- Traffic diversions will occur on Monday 4 August to install safety barriers
- Construction zone to be established in west bound lanes (Wangi to Hickey)

Upcoming night work and temporary closure of Wollombi Road

- Monday 4 August 2025 (1 night) (weather permitting)
- 7pm to 5am



Construction area
Road closure point
Traffic control to manage access for residents

Works: We will be installing safety barriers, completing line marking and

working on two water main crossings between O'Neill Street and Francis Street. Equipment will include hand tools, lighting towers,

excavators and trucks.

Why: The night works are necessary to ensure safety of the public and

minimise overall project impacts by installing the complete road

crossings.

Driveway access: There will be temporary impacts to some driveway access when works

within the construction areas commence. Impacted residents have been notified. Please follow the access signage once installed.

Street parking: Parking on Wollombi Road along the construction area has been

temporarily removed. Travel lanes are being repositioned to facilitate the upgrade work. Alternative parking is available on Wangi Ave, Desmond St, Hickey St and Francis Street. We encourage residents to leave parking on O'Neill St for residents who have driveway access

restrictions.

Speed limit: Reduced to 40km/h in the construction zone

Pedestrian access: Will be maintained at all times

Garbage collection: Please place your bins out as usual, and our team will ensure they get

emptied and returned. If any changes occur, we will let you know in

advance.
