

Wollombi Road Upgrade Project

Upcoming works – Catherine Street

We're reaching out to let you know that Cessnock Council is completing some emergency road maintenance at the intersection of Catherine Street & O'Neill Street tomorrow, 3 September. This work is being completed to improve the quality of the road surface in this area.

What does the work look like?

A machine will be used to remove the existing top layer of the road surface. After that, a new layer of asphalt will be laid, followed by compaction with a roller to ensure a smooth finish.

How will the work affect you?

Some construction noise is anticipated, and access to your driveways will be impacted. The Traffic Control team will be on site to manage your access as best as possible.

Will there be any road closures?

We will not be closing any roads for this work. Traffic controllers and signage will be in place, which will limit traffic to one direction at a time. Speed limits will also be reduced.
