

## Wollombi Road Upgrade: Night work

18 August 2025

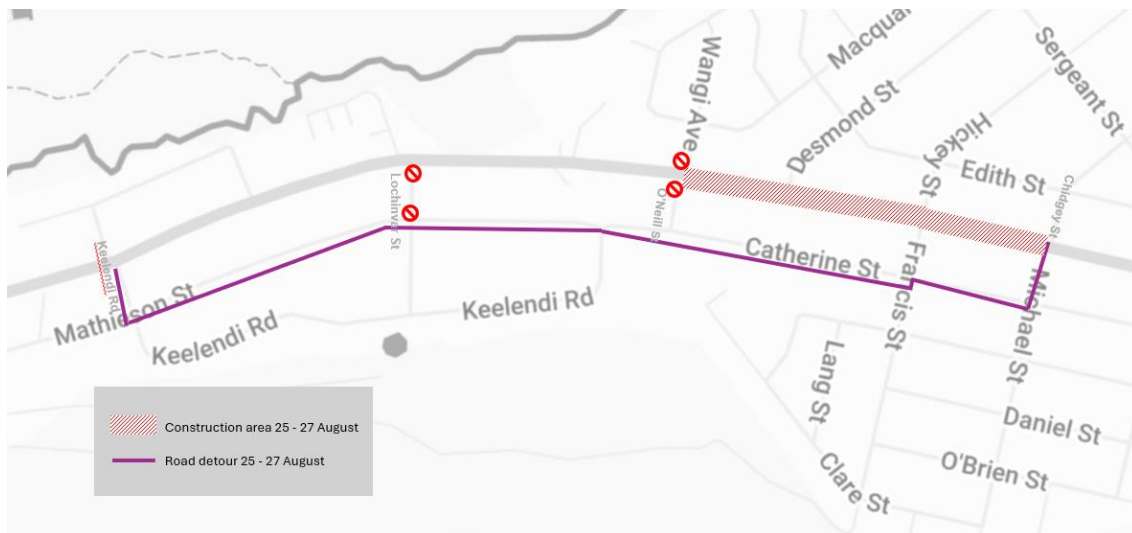
### Zone 1 & 3 night work change of date

#### What you need to know:

- Due to wet weather, previously advised night work for 19 to 21 August will now take place on Monday 25 to Wednesday 27 August (3 nights).
- Traffic diversions will be in place.

### Upcoming night work and temporary closure of Wollombi Road

- **Monday 25 August to Wednesday 27 August** (3 nights) (weather permitting) **7pm to 5am** work will be occurring on **Wollombi Road between Michael Street and O'Neill Street**. Traffic will be diverted from Michael Street, along Catherine and Mathieson Streets and onto Keelendi Road.
- Note: If work is unable to be completed due to wet weather, work will take place on 28-29 August.



**Work:** Between Michael Street and O'Neill Street – drainage works and line marking. Equipment will include saw cutter, excavator, hand tools, gas torch, trucks and solar lighting towers.

**Why:** The night works are necessary to ensure safety of the public and minimise overall project impacts by keeping Wollombi Road open during the day.

**Street parking:** Parking on Wollombi Road along the construction area between Francis St and O'Neill St (on both sides of Wollombi Road) has been temporarily removed.

Parking between Hickey and Chidgey Streets on the northern side of Wollombi Road will be temporarily removed following the night work.

Parking between Michael and Francis Streets on the southern side of Wollombi Road will be retained following night work.

**Speed limit:** Reduced to 40km/h in the construction zone

**Property access:** Traffic controllers will be in place to escort local residents in vehicles as required

**Pedestrian access:** Will be maintained at all times

**Garbage collection:** Please place your bins out as usual, and our team will ensure they get emptied and returned. If any changes occur, we will let you know in advance.
