

Wollombi Road Upgrade: Night work

Zone 3 Night work 2 - 4 September 2025

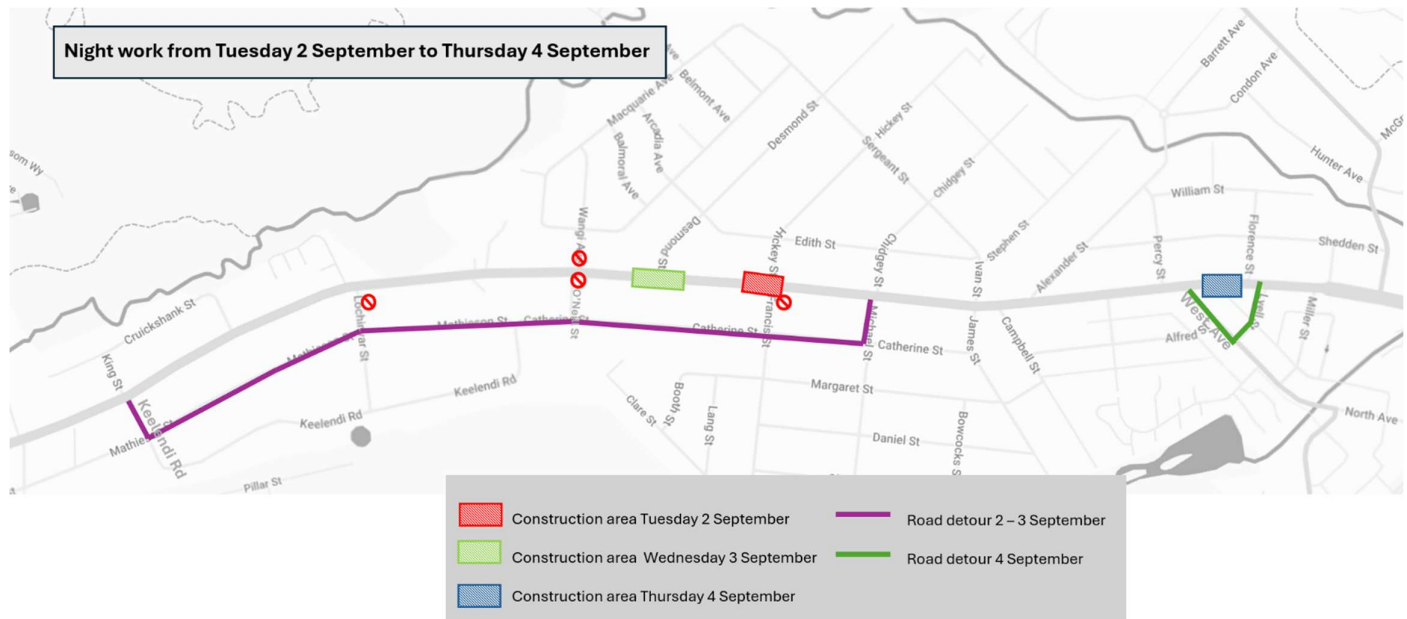
What you need to know:

- Night works will occur **Tuesday 2 September to Thursday 4 September (3 nights)** for telecommunications and utility work.
- Wollombi Rd will be closed and **traffic will be diverted** off Wollombi Rd at Michael St and Keelendi Rd and Lyell St and West Ave.

Upcoming night work

- **Tuesday 2 September** (1 night) (weather permitting) **7pm to 5am** at the **Francis St / Hickey St** intersection, shown in **red** below.
- **Wednesday 3 September** (1 night) (weather permitting) **7pm to 5am** at the **Desmond St / Wollombi Rd** intersection, shown in **green** below.
- **Thursday 4 September 2025** (1 night) (weather permitting) **7pm to 5am** between **West Ave and Lyell St**, shown in **blue** below.

Note: If work is unable to be completed due to wet weather, work will take place on Monday 8 September to Wednesday 10 September.



- Works:** We will be installing telecommunications and utility services across Wollombi Rd between Wangi Ave and Chidgey St and utility services between West Ave and Lyell St. No service interruptions are expected. Equipment will include saw cutter, excavator, compaction tools, hand tools, hand tools, solar lighting towers, and trucks.
- Why:** The night works are necessary to ensure safety of the public and minimise overall project impacts.
- Speed limit:** Reduced to 40km/h in the construction zone
- Driveway access:** Traffic controllers will be in place to escort local residents in vehicles as required.
- Pedestrian access:** Will be maintained at all times
- Garbage collection:** Please place your bins out as usual, and our team will ensure they get emptied and returned. If any changes occur, we will let you know in advance.
