Wollombi Road Upgrade: Night work

Zone 1 & 3 night work between 14 – 21 August

What you need to know:

- Night work and traffic diversions will occur from Thursday 14 August to
 Wednesday 20 August for essential drainage and electrical work.
- We will not work more than 3 nights in one area.

Upcoming night work and temporary closure of Wollombi Road

- Thursday 14 August (1 night) (weather permitting) 7pm to 5am on Wollombi Road between Francis Street and Lochinvar Street. Traffic will be diverted from Francis St, along Catherine and Mathieson St and onto Keelendi Road.
- Tuesday 19 August to Thursday 21 August (3 nights) (weather permitting) 7pm to 5am on Wollombi Road between Francis Street and O'Neill Street. Traffic will be diverted from Francis Street, along Catherine and Mathieson St and onto Lochinvar St.

Note: If work is unable to be completed due to wet weather, work will take place on 25-27 August.



Work:

Between O'Neill Street and Francis Street – drainage works. Equipment will include saw cutter, excavator, compaction tools, hand tools, trucks and solar lighting towers. Between Lochinvar Street and Francis Street – relocation of power poles. Equipment will include a crane borer, elevated work platforms,

hand tools, solar lighting towers and trucks.

Why: The night works are necessary to ensure safety of the public and

minimise overall project impacts by keeping Wollombi Road open

during the day.

Street parking: Parking on Wollombi Road along the construction area between

Francis St and O'Neill St has been temporarily removed.

Speed limit: Reduced to 40km/h in the construction zone

Property access: Traffic controllers will be in place to escort local residents as required.

Pedestrian access: Will be maintained at all times

Garbage collection: Please place your bins out as usual, and our team will ensure they get

emptied and returned. If any changes occur, we will let you know in

advance.
